To add 2-digit Numbers:

- 2. Add the tens (digit in the tens place)

<u>For PARENT/S</u>: Make sure your child will add the digit in the ones place first. You may ask him/her to draw an arrow on the ones place to help them remember to add that digit first. This will help them to add with regrouping in Second Grade.

Rime – is a word or word part (syllable) consisting of the vowel/s & any consonants that follow (\underline{at} , \underline{top} , \underline{rake})
