

## Mass Sacred Vessels and Linens

- 1. Chalice:** the sacred cup used during the Mass in which wine and water are mixed. After the Consecration, this cup holds the Blood of our Lord. It is usually made of precious metals.
- 2. Paten:** the Sacred Plate on which the host is placed. After the Consecration, this plate hold the Body of our Lord. Like the chalice, the paten is usually made of precious metals.
- 3. Ciborium:** the lidded chalice-like container that contains the consecrated hosts remaining after the Holy Communion. Jesus is reserved in a ciborium in the tabernacle.
- 4. Monstrance:** a beautiful holder in which the Blessed Sacrament is displayed. It is used during a prayer service called Benediction and Adoration. Jesus is placed in the center of the Monstrance for us to adore.
- 5. Cruets:** water and wine are kept in cruets which are used to pour the water and wine into the chalice.
- 6. Lavabo and finger cloth:** bowl and cloth use to wash the hands of the priest before Communion.
- 7. Corporal:** a sacred linen, upon which the Sacrifice of the Mass is offered. The Corporal is laid on top of the altar so that the Holy Eucharist is on a sacred linen.
- 8. Purificator:** a linen used to clean the sacred vessels.
- 9. Pall:** a starched square used to cover the chalice during parts of the Mass.
- 10. Tabernacle:** a beautiful box made of wood or precious metal. It is solid and kept locked. The tabernacle should be a centerpiece of the church. Jesus is kept in the tabernacle.


